




## Recall Recap

1,230 Food Recalls 92 Class I Recalls 61 Class II Recalls 11 Class III Recalls 174 Non-Food Recalls


# Data Spotlight - Spice Recalls Spike

Microbiological contamination, toxins and allergens contributed to a spike in spice recalls across Europe. Salmonella and Bacillus cereus were found in ginger which prompted ground ginger and spice mix recalls in France, Luxembourg, Belgium and Germany. Cumin and related spice mixes were recalled in France and Belgium due to presence of aflatoxins. And Cinnamon powder was recalled in Italy, Malta and Slovenia due to undeclared sulfur dioxide.



### Listeria Outbreaks Take Over in Q4

Of the more than 400 FoodTrack bulletins related to pathogens in Q4, over 50% were products impacted by Listeria, followed by Salmonella and E.coli. While Listeria events spanned across various products, the most heavily affected was the Meat & Poultry category.



Throughout Q4 and into early 2023, there have been four Listeria outbreaks that have led to CDC investigations:
